FAQ's



WHERE DO I TAKE RECYCLABLES?

The recycling trailer is located south of the library on Washington Street. **We accept the following items:** **Paper** (includes newspaper, magazines, phone books, paper books, office paper, junk mail, shredded paper, cereal boxes or other thin-layered boxes, i.e. paste-board); **Cardboard** (corrugated cardboard, brown paper bags. NO STYROFOAM); **Glass Bottles/Jars** (NO window glass, mirrors or light bulbs. NO ceramics or drinking glasses); **Aluminum** (aluminum cans, pop, beer and juice) NO CAT FOOD CANS, NO PIE TINS, NO ALUMINUM FOIL; **Tin Cans** (labels may be left on); **Plastic** (#1 - water, pop, sport drink, salad dressing, kitchen bottles. #2 - milk jugs (flattened), detergent jugs, shampoo bottles, bleach jugs). Remove all lids. **Only #1 and #2 Plastic.** PLEASE rinse all bottles, jugs and cans. NO PLASTIC BAGS, NO MOTOR OIL, NO AUTO PRODUCT BOTTLES, NO LAWN CHEMICAL BOTTLES, NO PESTICIDE BOTTLES.

WHERE DO I TAKE MATTRESSES, APPLIANCES, TIRES, FURNITURE...? Contact the Village Office at 308-848-2228 to make arrangements to take the items to the roll off container.

WHERE CAN I DISPOSE OF YARD WASTE? Yard waste can be taken to the south edge of Old Mill Park, located on South Broadway Street. **REMINDER: SEPARATE TREE BRANCHES FROM GRASS CLIPPINGS.**

WHERE DO I TAKE CONSTRUCTION RUBBLE? Arnold has a construction demolition site that is located one mile north of Arnold. You must call the Village Office at 308-848-2228 to make arrangements to go to the Construction Demolition Site. Your load must be weighed at Country Partners which is located on East 2nd Ave. The fee for Construction Demolition is \$50.00 per ton. **REMINDER: DO NOT PUT CONSTRUCTION RUBBLE, TIRES, YARD WASTE...IN DUMPSTERS!!**

WHO DO I CALL TO MARK WHERE UTILITIES ARE BURIED ON MY PROPERTY?

811 is the national call-before-you-dig phone number. Anyone who plans to dig is **REQUIRED** to call 811 to request that the approximate location of buried utilities be marked with paint or flags. **PLEASE WAIT** until this work has been completed before you dig.

DO I NEED A BUILDING PERMIT?

All new construction, including additions, decks, garages, accessory buildings, enclosing a porch, patio covers, carports and fences need a building permit. Building permits may be obtained at the Village Office at 209 W 1st Avenue. For more information, please contact Mike Harvey, Interim Zoning Administrator, at 308-530-1065.

DOES THE VILLAGE OFFER AUTOMATIC WITHDRAWAL ON UTILITY BILLS?

The Village does offer ACH payment of utility bills. With this service, no matter where you bank, you can have your utility bill payment automatically withdrawn from your checking account. Contact Patty Lamberty, Village Clerk, at 308-848-2228 for more information.

DOES THE VILLAGE OFFER SOLID WASTE SERVICES TO RURAL RESIDENTS?

Rural residents can sign up at the Village Office for Solid Waste Services. Rural customers will be billed quarterly (\$45.00 per quarter) for this service. Rural Dumpsters are located south of the library on Washington Street. Unless you sign up for solid waste services, you **CANNOT** use the Village Dumpsters. **EVERYONE** can use the Recycling Trailers. For more information, contact the Village Office at 308-848-2228.
