In her later years, she moved back to Arnold where she lived with her sister, Julie, and brother-in law, Randy, and dedicated herself to growing a large garden, canning, and caregiving for several Arnold residents. Jeani spent her final years in McCook working at the hospital until she retired in 2020.

Jeani was a fiercely independent woman who wasn't afraid to speak her mind. She drove as if the left lane on the interstate "belonged" to her, much



to the horror of any passengers. She had a "need for speed" and had many cherished cars over the years, the final one a Chevy Camaro SS.

She was tough on the outside but had a soft heart. One of her greatest joys were her nieces and nephews. She always spent time shopping for them and got so excited watching them open their gifts. She was always a cat lover and her cats, Tipsy and Gypsy, gave her comfort and companionship in her final years.

Jeani was preceded in death by her parents, James and Sherry Davenport; her grandparents, Darrel and Freda (Bowers) Hircock, Orville and Mary Davenport, and grandmother, Lola (Bean) Davenport; sisters, Joni Claymon and JoDee Kimball; brothers, Michael and Jimmy Davenport; and nephew, Andrew Claymon.
